Email sent to Senior Rights of Way Officer Footpath 12 - the section immediately adjacent to the road by Boxford Mill. It is a very narrow section and due to the very wet winter/spring it became impassable - a sea of mud in fact. Having dried out, it is now very uneven to the point of ankle breaking apparently and needs rolling. From the end of the narrow section leading into and along the field, the footpath is well maintained. Being part of the Lambourn Valley Way it is an important section with no alternative available.  Footpath 15 - is totally impassable from the Leckhampstead Road end to the field gate. It has not been managed at all well since the new landowner has taken over Nettles and thistles are waist high, and the original path has disappeared. This footpath is part of a short circular Boxford walk - so it's a great pity when it's lost. Footpath 5 - through the farm buildings and a short stretch thereafter is fine but the remainder is again waist high nettles, making it impassable.
